## Privately Funded Scholarships

### *Accounting, Finance & Law Scholarships*

- **Accounting, Finance & Law Department Scholarship**  
Dependent upon amount of available funds.  
Requirements:
  - Full-time accounting major who is a deserving student
  - Consideration will be given to academic achievement, integrity, conduct, financial need, character, leadership and professionalism.
  - Preference will be given to those who will be juniors and above in the Fall.
- **Citizens Bank Seniors Club Scholarship**  
\$500 for fall semester, provided earnings of the funds are sufficient.
  - Students must be a Northeast Arkansas resident.
  - Majoring in the College of Business with a desire to pursue banking as a career.
  - Completed a minimum of 30 hours at ASU.
  - Full-time senior with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in undergraduate hours, or in graduate program with a cumulative grade point average of 3.50.

### **Orthany Paden Dekker Memorial Scholarship**

Amount depends on annual interest income.

- Incoming freshman who is majoring in accounting.
- Full-time student demonstrating outstanding academic achievement and commitment to a career in accounting or a related field.

To maintain scholarship, must continue to be a full-time student majoring in accounting or a related field with at least a 3.0 grade point average.

Accounting Department

\$2,000 per academic year, provided funds are available, payable at \$1,000 for fall and \$1,000 for spring, for maximum of two semesters.

- Undergraduate Accounting major (must have progressed to point where there is reasonable certainty of obtaining BS in Accounting) or graduate student taking classes toward CPA exam eligibility.

- Factors to be considered in selection of student include academic achievement, GPA, integrity, and common sense.

- Financial need considered, but student should not be receiving other financial aid from the university (except work-study, loans, wages, etc.).

- Not limited to Arkansas residents.

- Student is eligible to renew scholarship for eight academic semesters or until completion of undergraduate degree, whichever comes first, provided all criteria is met.

- Student must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0.
- Scholarship may be renewed provided recipient continues to meet criteria and maintains a 3.0 and above grade point average.

  - Full time student during the academic year of the award.
 In order to maintain scholarship, student must continue to meet selection criteria.

Tuition (not to exceed \$1,600 per student per academic year) available upon completion of undergraduate degree or eight academic semesters, whichever occurs first, provided fund earnings are sufficient. A recipient will be selected each year, working toward a total of four recipients - a freshman, sophomore, junior and senior. Renewal is automatic, provided recipient continues to meet scholarship criteria.

- Incoming freshman, Arkansas resident.

- Full-time student majoring in any field of business with a minimum ACT of 24.

- Where possible, scholarship should be used to recruit full-time entering freshmen who might not otherwise attend ASU.

Recipient must be enrolled full-time in the College of Business, in good academic standing and must have satisfactory behavior and personal conduct to maintain scholarship.

Initial award of \$500 for the Spring semester. Beginning with Fall semester, award of \$1,000 per academic year, payable at \$500 per semester, and thereafter provided funds are available.

- Recipient shall be a rising sophomore or junior level student pursuing any degree within the College of Business.

- Preference given to nontraditional student with economic need.

- A minimum of 3.0 overall grade point average (3.0/4.0 scale).

\$1,000 annually, payable at \$500 per semester, provided earnings of the fund are sufficient. Renewal for three additional years.
  - Incoming freshman who is a College of Business major.
  - Student must have a minimum ACT of 27 and rank in the upper 5% of their high school graduating class or a National Merit Semi-Finalist or Finalist.

Student must maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.25 and continue to meet all criteria in order to maintain scholarship.

- **Fred Stull Fellowship for Graduate Study in Business**  
\$2,500 annually, payable at the rate of \$1,250 per semester. In the event earnings of the account are insufficient to fund the award at this level, donor agrees to provide additional funding to make the award.
  - Recipient shall be at least an incoming graduate student accepted and enrolled in the MBA program with a minimum 3.0 grade point average (3.0/4.0 scale).
  - Preference given to the descendants of natives of the lands that were prime contributors to the development of the English language (German, French, Celtic and Latin-Italian).

Recipient must be enrolled in the MBA program with a minimum 3.0 grade point average. Not automatically renewable, recipients may reapply.

University Scholarship Committee chooses recipient.  
Two annual awards of \$2,500 each per academic year payable at \$1,250 per academic semester for each recipient. One (1) scholarship will be awarded to a non-traditional student, and one (1) scholarship shall be awarded to an incoming freshman.
  - A minimum high school or college undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale is required.
  - May seek any degree within the College of Business.
  - Financial need shall be considered.
  - Must be a full-time student during semester of award.
 These awards are automatically renewable through completion of the undergraduate degree or eight (8) academic semesters, whichever occurs first, provided recipient continues to meet criteria and maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on 4.0 scale.
